INTRODUCTION TO THE BIBLE

Part LIII: 2 Thessalonians

After the masterful letter which was 1 Thessalonians, the brethren at Thessalonica would have been duly encouraged by Paul to look to the skies with great anticipation for the second coming of the Lord. He referred to that coming in every chapter and focused upon it in 1 Thessalonians 4:14-18 which included such motivation as "sorrow not," "[living Christians] shall be caught up together with [faithful Christians who had already did] ... to meet the Lord in the air," and "comfort one another." The whole section was a pep talk for enduring the present opposition! Sadly, some had taken Paul too much at his word, expecting that they specifically of that generation were the "we" of 1 Thessalonians 4:15,17. "Obviously," they apparently thought, since they were the ones told, "Let us watch and be sober" (1 The. 5:6). Accordingly, some in Thessalonica had put their physical lives in "cruise control" expecting Jesus' imminent arrival.

Paul (2 The. 3:17), again with Silas and Timothy likely as amanuenses (cf 1 The. 1:1), wrote the Thessalonian brethren (2 The. 1:1). Given the purpose of his writing, it is likely that this letter followed within just months the first. The same arguments, then, urged for the place of origin of 1 Thessalonians would apply for this letter--he probably wrote this epistle from Corinth (especially given the length of time he was in Corinth [Acts 18:11]). That purpose was to clear up misconceptions some had regarding the Second Coming after having received 1 Thessalonians (2 The. 2:2). Interestingly, Paul suggested that while they could look with eagerness to the skies, they might also be shaken or troubled fearing that return was soon to occur. There is no reason supplied for that reaction, but it is possible--though speculative--that some were concerned for the souls of loved ones who had not yet accepted the Gospel. He let them know in this epistle that other events had to transpire first (2 The. 2:3). While the roots of that inevitability

were already present (2 The. 2:7), the full realization, and, therefore, the Second Coming were not in the foreseeable future. (*To be continued next week*)
