### INTRODUCTION TO THE BIBLE Daniel F. Cates

## Part LV: 2 Timothy

(Continued from last week) The key words of 2 Timothy are "faith," used eight times for both personal faith and the system of faith, and "word," used four times for both God's Word and the word of false teachers. The key verses include the public directive of 2 Timothy 2:2, "And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also," and the personal directive of 2 Timothy 2:15, "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." The key passages include the edifying affirmation "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works" (2 Tim. 3:16,17) and the sobering challenge "I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom; Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables. But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry" (2 Tim. 4:1-5).

Here are some of the great lessons from 2 Timothy: first, just because conscience is not the standard does not mean it can be violated (2 Tim. 1:3); second, the source of miraculous ability was the laying on of an apostle's hands (2 Tim. 1:6; cf. Acts 8:18); third, God did not originate fear (2 Tim. 1:7; cf. 1 John 4:18); fourth, man's salvation was purchased and prepared in the eternal past (2 Tim. 1:9); fifth, there is no shame in suffering for Christ (2 Tim. 1:12); sixth, God's Word provides a pattern for man (2 Tim. 1:13); seventh, even the great need encouragement (2 Tim. 1:16-18) and help (2 Tim. 4:11); eighth, one could wrongly divide Truth, so he has the responsibility to study (2 Tim. 2:15); ninth, one who is faithful need not worry whether the Lord will be (2 Tim. 2:19); tenth, being "a little" godly is not enough (2 Tim. 3:5); eleventh, all righteous will be persecuted to some degree (2 Tim. 3:12); twelfth, the Scriptures are sufficient to lead one to salvation (2 Tim. 3:15-17); thirteenth, Christians are responsible for spreading the Gospel (2 Tim. 4:1-2; cf 2 Cor. 4:5-7); fourteenth, the righteous will be rewarded (2 Tim. 4:7-8); fifteenth, God will always encourage the righteous (2 Tim. 4:17-18).
