INTRODUCTION TO THE BIBLE Daniel F. Cates

Part LVI: Titus

(Continued from last week) The key word of the book is "doctrine" which is used four times, twice preceded by "sound" or healthy, once followed by "of God" Who is the source of sound doctrine, and once showing that Titus was to be "a pattern ... in doctrine" The key passages include Titus 1:5-9 with its qualifications for elders (supplementing the qualifications revealed in 1 Tim. 3:1-7) and Titus 3:1,2 (showing that the Cretans needed Titus to "Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work, To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, but gentle, shewing all meekness unto all men.").

Among the lessons from this book are these: first, Truth is objective (Tit. 1:1); second, false teachers must be silenced (Tit. 1:11); third, teachers may use outside sources for illustration (Tit. 1:12; cf. Acts 17:28); fourth, additions do not aid Truth (Tit. 1:14); fifth, lip service is not true service (Tit. 1:16); sixth, all have responsibilities (Tit. 2:1-10); seventh, God shed His grace on men through Christ (Tit. 2:11-15; 3:7); eighth, one can joyfully look for the Second Coming (Tit. 2:13); ninth, some would undo the good they teach through the bad they do (Tit. 2:15); tenth, even bad governments like Rome's must be obeyed (Tit. 3:1-2); eleventh, once lost does not mean always lost (Tit. 3:3); twelfth, washing is required for cleansing (Tit. 3:5; cf. Acts 22:16; Eph. 5:26); thirteenth, the best way to solve problems is to avoid them (Tit. 3:8); fourteenth, some things are better left alone (Tit. 3:9); and, fifteenth, one who is disfellowshipped has already disfellowshipped himself (Tit. 3:10-11).

"That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:" (Ephesians 4:14,15)
