INTRODUCTION TO THE BIBLE Daniel F. Cates

Part XXX: Amos

(*Continued from last week*) Though one of the "Minor Prophets," Amos--like the others of this portion of Scripture--contains many great lessons including these: first, all nations are amenable to God (Amos 1-2); second, mothers and their unborn are separate beings (Amos 1:13); third, those whom God has blessed should not take His blessings for granted (Amos 3:1-2); fourth, one wishing to walk with God must agree with Him (Amos 3:3); fifth, one must be prepared for judgment (Amos 4:12; cf. Mat. 24:44,46); sixth, one cannot escape from judgment (Amos 5:19); seventh, without the proper attitude; service, sacrifice, and giving are unacceptable and unaccepted (Amos 5:21-24); eighth, complacency and misplaced trust are dooming (Amos 6:1); ninth, none are greater than God (Amos 6:8; Heb. 6:13); tenth, there is a standard of uprightness (Amos 7:7-8); eleventh, the righteous will face opposition (Amos 7:13) and false accusations (Amos 7:12); twelfth, the defense of the righteous is God (Amos 7:15); thirteenth, there will come a time when it is too late to obey (Amos 8:11-12); fourteenth, one cannot hide from God (Amos 9:1-4); fifteenth, people of God can so sin as to fall (Amos 9:10).

Part XXXI: Obadiah

Not many popularly know much, if anything, about the Edomites; in fact, though they were important Biblically, many Bible students would be equally ignorant of them. This in spite of their being descendants of Abraham and Isaac via Esau (Gen. 36:8). Ignorant in spite of their importance when the children of Israel desired to enter the Promised Land (Num. 20:14-21). Ignorant in spite of their role in Babylon's destruction of Judah (Eze. 35:5; Amos 1:11). Ignorant in spite of their being the forerunners of the New Testament's King Herod the Great the Idumaean [Edom's Greek name] (Josephus, *Antiquities of the Jews*, XIV.x.iii.1; xii.2; xv.14; XV.vi.7, XIV.xiii.1; *Wars of the Jews*, I.xx.1-3; et al). In spite of her receiving some attention in nineteen Old Testament books (Gen., Exo., Num., Deu., 1 & 2 Sam., 1 & 2 Kin., 1 & 2 Chr., Psa., Isa., Jer., Lam., Eze., Joel, Amos, Oba., and Mal.). Above all, this ignorance is in spite of the attention give to Edom in the prophetic book specifically focusing upon her, Obadiah. (*To be continued next week*)
