INTRODUCTION TO THE BIBLE Daniel F. Cates

Part LIX: James

There are three or four men in the New Testament who went by the name James. Two were apostles, James son of Zebedee and brother of John (Mat. 10:2; Acts 12:2) and James the son of Alphaeus also called James "the less" (Mat. 10:3; Mark 15:40), one was half-brother of Jesus (Mat. 13:55; Gal. 1:19) and a pillar of the church in Jerusalem (Gal. 2:9; cf. Acts 15:13), a fourth may have been the father or brother (depending on translation) of Thaddaeus, one of the apostles called Judas (Luke 6:16; cf. John 14:22)--though some think this James was James the less. One of these men wrote the book that bears the name James. Due his early death, James the brother of John is quickly eliminated from contention. Of the other two or three, James "the less" and/or Thaddaeus kinsman are not likely due to his/their relatively minor role(s) in the Bible narrative. Tradition and most commentators suggest that the writer of the book is James, the half-brother of the Lord [and full brother of Jude who also wrote one of the general epistles]. Tradition has the half-brother of James being martyred in Jerusalem about A.D. 62. Such a writer certainly fits the recipients of the book: Scattered Jewish Christians (Jam. 1:1; cf. Acts 8:1). These would have scattered to varied places throughout the Roman empire.

If this James were the writer, then Jerusalem was the likely place where the book was written (Gal. 1:18,19). One might argue that the place of origin would allow for an early date and the authorship by John's brother; however, the date was not very early, for the Jerusalem Christians not only had time to scattered, but also the name Christian had likely already been given by the time the book was written (Jam. 2:7; cf. Acts 11:26). James, John's brother, was martyred about the time the name was given. One the other hand, the book was not written real late because A.D. 70 with the Lord's vengeance against the Jews had not yet come (Jam. 5:8-9; cf. Mat. 24:30). One might note also that if this James were the author and if he died in A.D. 62, then it could have been written no later than that. A famine in A.D. 44 may have prompted passages like Jam. 1:27 and 2:15-18; however, the focus of that difficulty would have been from where these had scattered, so there may not be a necessary, direct correlation time-wise. A broad date for the writing of James would be late 40's to early 60's with the early to mid-50's being most likely.

These brethren weren't perfect (Jam. 1:22-27; 4:1-12; 5:1-6), but they were still brethren who had needed to remain faithful in spite of the persecution that scattered abroad-encouragement to be strong was the purpose of the epistle. (*To be continued next week*)
