#### **FAMILY ROLES**

#### **Daniel Cates**

Very simply, God is the Author of the home. He ordained it from the beginning (Genesis 2:24,25); moreover, though the world today strive in many ways to destroy the family, God's Word is still very simple and clear when it comes to family constitution and the associated family roles (Genesis 2:18-25; 18:19; Matthew 19:4-6; 1 Corinthians 11:3; Ephesians 5:22-33; 6:1-4; Colossians 3:18-21)! Two sets of roles will be considered in this brief study: husbands and wives; then, parents and children.

The head of the family is the husband. Paul plainly wrote, "For the husband is the head of the wife, ..." (Ephesians 5:23). When there is a head, there is also that subordinate to the head. The wife is subordinate to he husband; again, Paul was very plain, writing, "Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, ..." (Ephesians 5:22 and Colossians 3:18 begin with these identical words). Two things are worthy of note: first, these things were not merely penned by Paul, they were the Spirit inspired Word of God expressed through the writing of Paul; second, these are not the complete passages—they have been presented with neither the motivation nor any associated action.

Read further: That the husband is head is due his being an analogue of Christ. Paul wrote that the husband is head "... even as Christ is the head of the church: ...." There is nothing particularly special about chromosomal difference between males and females (XY as opposed to XX), but in a properly functioning body there can be only one head; accordingly, because man was created first (1 Timothy 2:13) and Eve was first deceived "in the transgression" (1 Timothy 2:14), God deemed it proper that in the body of the family the male would be like Christ in His marriage to the church, so "as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands" (Ephesians 5:24). The church complements Christ and He complements the church, so, when properly organized, the home has complementary partners in the husband and wife. The motivation to be the proper fit for the role is to be Christ-like and church-like; that is, Godly! Regarding action, husbands love their wives (Ephesians 5:25; Colossians 3:19) and wives reverence, or honor, their husbands (Ephesians 5:33). This is God's plan regardless of what culture might argue.

The next roles in the home are of parents and children. Families should have two parents: a father and a mother. The father is to bring up children "in the nurture and admonition of the Lord" (Ephesians 6:4). The wife is to exert her authority as "second in command" in the family. 1 Timothy 5:14 refers to her role thus: *oikodespoten* (Greek οικοδεσποτειν); that is, "guide the house," which could be translated "rule [master] the house." She is not inferior to her husband, she is merely his second in command! Often, indeed too often, it is the mother who is the true leader, especially spiritually, in the home; such a mother

can be a great blessing to a child as Lois was to Eunice and as both were to Timothy (2 Timothy 1:5). The children are to obey (Ephesians 6:1; Colossians 3:20) and honor (Ephesians 6:2--this even implies eventual financial support, if necessary (cf 1 Timothy 5:4) their parents; moreover, children would do well to determine early to godly husbands, wives, fathers, and mothers themselves!

These are the family roles as God would have them; let all Christian's respect His Will!

"That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:" (Ephesians 4:14,15)
