INTRODUCTION TO THE BIBLE Daniel F. Cates

Part XXXVIII: Zechariah

(Continued from last week) Like Haggai, Zechariah prophesied "unto the Jews that were in Judah and Jerusalem" (Ezra 5:1); it is a tribute to the two of them that "the elders of the Jews builded [Zerubbabel's temple-DFC], and they prospered through the prophesying of Haggai the prophet and Zechariah the son of Iddo ["son of" could refer to "grandson of" as well as "son of"-DFC]. And they builded, and finished it, according to the commandment of the God of Israel, and according to the commandment of Cyrus, and Darius, and Artaxerxes king of Persia." He would certainly have prophesied from Jerusalem where the building was taking place. The prophecy of Zechariah is dated from "the eighth month, in the second year of Darius" (Zec. 1:1) to "the fourth year of king Darius, ... in the fourth day of the ninth month, even in Chisleu" (Zec. 7:1); as Darius reigned over Persia from 521-486 B.C., the years of the prophecy were 520-518 B.C.

Zechariah wrote for the same reason Haggai had: To motivate work on the temple (Zec. 1:16; 4:9); the book of Zechariah has an aspect here, though, that Haggai's had not: The building of Zerubbabel's temple prefigured the building of the Messiah's (Zec. 6:12,13)! In fact, much of Zechariah's prophecy is presented in apocalyptic form--which, while such can deal with themes such as destruction, ultimately presents the triumph of a future hope.

The key words of the book are "house" (used thirty-one times; especially as a description of the Lord house, the "temple" [which word itself is found five times]), and "build"/"built" (found seven times between the two forms), and "turn" (found six times, giving a picture of repentance). The key phrases are "the Lord of hosts" (found fifty-three times; one should remember that a "host" is a number of people, especially one like an army) and "it shall come to pass" (found twelve times, showing the surety of the prophecy at hand). The key verses could be many, but here are three: first, Zechariah 1:14, "So the angel that communed with me said unto me, Cry thou, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; I am jealous for Jerusalem and for Zion with a great jealousy" (that "jealousy" is not a petty envying or coveting, but an expectation of what rightly belongs to sovereign God); second, Zechariah 4:10, "For who hath despised the day of small things? for they shall rejoice, and shall see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel with those seven; they are the eyes of the LORD, which run to and fro through the whole earth" (revealing the importance of small things which man may view as insignificant, the existence of

standards, and the omniscience of God); and, third, Zechariah 9:9, "Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he *is* just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass" (a wonderfully, but not surprisingly, precise prophecy of Jesus; note its fulfillment in Matthew 21:1-9).
