## INTRODUCTION TO THE BIBLE Daniel F. Cates

Part XL: Matthew

(Continued from last week) The key words of the book are "king" (used twenty times), "kingdom" (fifty-six times), and "fulfil" or "fulfilled" (used eighteen times between the two forms) which all support the purpose of the book. Another word, "verily" (Greek ἀμήν) is found thirty times in the book; it is the word from which the English amen has come and signifies the truthfulness or surety of a matter. The key phrases "it is written" is found nine times, again pointing to the purpose of the book; a similar expression, "have ye not/never read" is found an additional six times. The key verse of the book shows what the Jews had willingly missed; Matthew 28:18 reads, "And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth." Numerous key passages include Matthew 1:18-25 (on Jesus' prophesied and miraculous birth); Matthew 5:2-12 (the famed "beatitudes"); Matthew 6:9-13 (the model prayer--sometimes incorrectly called "the Lord's prayer" which better applies to John 17); Matthew 11:28-30 (Jesus' invitation); and Matthew 16:21-26 (which implies the soul's true value). The key chapters of the book include Matthew 13 (Jesus' kingdom parables); Matthew 24 (contrasting the warning and events of A.D. 70 with the wholly different Second Coming); and Matthew 26-28 (containing the trial, crucifixion, and resurrection of Jesus).

The key lessons of the book are manifold; while here are a great number, many more could be included! First, Jesus is worthy to receive worship (Mat. 2:2,11; 14:33); second, Jesus did the Father's Will (Mat. 3:15; 6:10; cf. Luke 22:42) and so pleased Him (Mat. 3:17); third, God's Word should be utilized in battling temptation (Mat. 4:4,7,10); fourth, one's influence must be good and evident (Mat. 5:13-16); fifth, those acting to be seen of men will only have reward in this life (Mat. 6:1-6,16-18); sixth, ones who will not forgive will not be forgiven (Mat. 6:14,15); seventh, few will be saved (Mat. 7:13,14); eighth, those who would be blessed by God must do His Will (Mat. 7:21; 12:50); ninth, one must confess Christ, not deny Him (Mat. 10:32,33); tenth, one must replace wickedness with righteousness (Mat. 12:43-45); eleventh, spiritual family is more important than physical family (Mat. 12:47-50; cf. 10:35-37); twelfth, Jesus was greater than Moses and Elijah as was His system greater than the law and the prophets (Mat. 17:1-5); thirteenth, children are not born sinful, but innocent, and must be emulated by those who would be righteous (Mat. 18:1-6); fourteenth, God's children must always be prepared and willing to forgive (Mat. 18:21,22; 19:14); fifteenth, marriage is for life (Mat. 19:1-9); sixteenth, one must be prepared and willing to sacrifice all for Christ (Mat. 19:16-24); seventeenth, even Jesus could not save those who do not want to be saved (Mat. 23:37); and, eighteenth, no signs will precede the Second Coming (Mat. 24:36-51)-therefore, one must ever be ready (Mat. 25:1-13).

As a final note, there is some debate over whether Matthew was written in Hebrew or Greek; in reality, though, it is of no consequence, for the Holy Spirit has known both languages and it truly was He who penned this account [as, indeed, He did all of Scripture (2 Tim. 3:16,17; 2 Pet. 1:21)].

"That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:" (Ephesians 4:14,15)
