INTRODUCTION TO THE BIBLE Daniel F. Cates

Part XV: Ezra

(Continued from last week) The key words of the book fit the mission of Ezra: "Law," used 9 times, reminds the reader of what Ezra sought to restore; "decree," also used 9 times, reminds the reader of the Persian allowance of the Jews efforts but also of the supreme, unalterable Persian rule (cf Est. 1:19; Dan. 6:15). The key verses, back to back in Ezra 7:9,10, are those showing Ezra's return and, more significantly for the Christian, Ezra's preparation; respectively, these verses read, "For upon the first day of the first month began he to go up from Babylon, and on the first day of the fifth month came he to Jerusalem, according to the good hand of his God upon him" and "For Ezra had prepared his heart to seek the law of the LORD, and to do it, and to teach in Israel statutes and judgments." The key passage, Ezra 1:1-4, is the aforementioned decree of Cyrus with verse 4 giving more of Cyrus decree than is recorded in the close of 2 Chronicles. Ezra added there, "And whosoever remaineth in any place where he sojourneth, let the men of his place help him with silver, and with gold, and with goods, and with beasts, beside the freewill offering for the house of God that is in Jerusalem." That decree also sets off the key chapter, with the rest of Ezra 1 showing the response of the captives to Cyrus' decree and Cyrus' own aid for their efforts--the return of the goods "which Nebuchadnezzar had brought forth out of Jerusalem" (2 Kin. 24:13; cf 2 Kin. 20:13,17).

Numerous wonderful lessons (much more encouraging than those in the preceding generally sad books from Judges through 2 Chronicles) may be gleaned from the book of Ezra. Among them are these: first, God's prophecies come to pass (Ezra 1:1-4), for the return had not only been the subject of prophecy (Jer. 29:14), but a century and half before his birth, Cyrus had been named (Isa. 44:28); second, the ten tribes were never "lost" (Ezra 2:70; 7:7; 8:29,35), as has already been demonstrated; third, that which rightly belongs to one should be no other's (Ezra 1:7-11), as in the return of "the vessels of the house of the Lord"; fourth, God works providentially (Ezra 7:9), as shown by God's "good hand" directing the return of Ezra; fifth, obedience begins in the heart (Ezra 7:10), as was shown by Ezra's preparation which included seeking, doing, and teaching "in Israel [God's-DFC] statutes and judgments."

"That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:" (Ephesians 4:14,15)
