## INTRODUCTION TO THE BIBLE Daniel F. Cates

Part XLIII: John

(Continued from last week) While Matthew wrote to Jews, Mark to Romans, and Luke to a Gentile, John really wrote for all men, but especially the church! Given the assumed time of the book and the persecution which ones were to be willing to suffer on the Lord's behalf, it would be only fitting that a book be penned to show that Jesus was God (John 1:1) and that His sacrifice was effectual for all (John 3:16; 12:32,33); John would word this in stating his purpose, "these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name" (John 20:31).

The key words of the book include "word" (used 22 times, among them it is used repeatedly in John 1 to refer to Jesus Who in a similar thought in Hebrews 1:3 was referred to as "the express image of" God), "believe" (found fifty-two times), and "life" (found forty-four times). The key phrase, "I am" (used eighteen times in John, and numerous times in the Revelation), ties the reader back to Exodus 3:14 and the voice from the burning bush: "And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you." The import of the thought concerned the eternal self-existence of the one speaking--that same eternal self-existence is the nature of Jesus (note John 8:24, especially when removing the "he" from versions which contain it)--the italics show it was added by translators to help express the thought though actually the addition detracted from Jesus' true point. The key verses are John 1:14 (which spoke of the Word's being made flesh--an unquestionable allusion to Jesus), John 3:16 (one of the most popular [but sadly misunderstood] passages showing the breadth of God's love), and John 21:25 (which indicates that John, and for that matter the other Gospel account recorders, really just gave the highlights). The key passage is John 20:30,31 in which John state's his purpose in writing the book. The key chapter is Jesus' prayer of John 17. While some will call the model prayer of Matthew 6:9-13 "the Lord's Prayer," that was not a prayer He could word (He had no sin needing to be forgiven); truly, "the Lord's Prayer" is in John 17.
