INTRODUCTION TO THE BIBLE Daniel F. Cates

Part XLV: Romans

Rome played an integral part in Bible history: she was prophesied concerning in places like Daniel 2:33-35,40-45 and 7:7,8,23-26; she was at times the location of Aquila and Priscilla (Acts 18:2), of Paul and Luke and their fellow travelers (Acts 28:16), and Onesiphorus (2 Tim. 1:16,17), and many others (Rom. 16); she was the primary persecutor of the early church (hence the Revelation). From a secular standpoint, she was powerful, but wicked; one of her own, Juvenal, satirically condemned her excess (Satire VI.290-293) and immorality (cf Satire II.121-129); he wrote, "even among the dead Rome stands dishonoured" (Satire II.160-170). Rome was not a godly place in general; however, Rome also played a part Scripturally in being home to numerous congregations of the Lord's people--including one in Aquila and Priscilla's home (Rom. 16:2-5), another which included Asyncritus, Phlegon, Hermas, Patrobas, Hermes, and other brethren (Rom. 16:14), and another which included Philologus, Julia, Nereus, Olympas, and others (Rom. 16:15). The book of Romans is a letter to those brethren.

Paul was the writer of this letter (Rom.1:1; cf. 11:13; 15:15-20; Acts 22:21; 26:17-18); that much is simply stated. There is more to the authorship of this and other works written by Paul, however, than simply noting his authorship. Paul would often use amanuenses, ones who would take his spoken words and write them. Paul would use numerous amanuenses through the years, and such is often reflected in the uninspired postscripts of the books which he wrote. His using an amanuensis did not detract from his being inspired of God to write these letters, for they were the equivalent of secretaries taking dictation. In the case of the letter to the Romans, Tertius was Paul's amanuensis; he wrote, "I Tertius, who wrote *this* epistle, salute you in the Lord" (Rom. 16:22). (*To be continued next week*)
