INTRODUCTION TO THE BIBLE Daniel F. Cates

Part XLVI: 1 Corinthians

Paul's letters reveal much concerning Paul as a Christian, apostle, missionary, preacher, teacher, mentor, friend, and so forth; at times, his letters reveal much concerning those to whom he wrote as well. His letter which is generally simply identified as First Corinthians shows a congregation in Corinth (1 Cor. 1:2) which had many good members (1 Cor. 1:4-8), but which also had its share of problems (1 Cor. 1:11; 5:1) and questions (1 Cor. 7:1). Paul's purpose in writing was to help the church in Corinth to get away from the divisions and worldliness which she faced and to hold to the doctrine of Christ.

The letter at hand was indeed written by Paul (1 Cor. 16:21)--one will note that Paul penned the salutation with his own hand. The implication is that someone else did the bulk of the writing. The uninspired postscript names Stephanas, Fortunatus, Achaicus, and Timothy; however, in 1 Corinthians 1:1, Paul mentioned that he was writing with "Sosthenes our brother." It is, then quite reasonable, that Sosthenes would have been Paul's amanuensis. Who was this Sosthenes? Some have suggested that he is the same Sosthenes mentioned in Acts 18:17, "the chief ruler of the synagogue." The location would fit due to Sosthenes' connection to Corinth; however, any direct link between the two is not certain, for such a link requires three things of which there is no record: first, Sosthenes' not being adversarial to Paul; second, Sosthenes' conversion; and, third, Sosthenes' leaving Corinth to accompany Paul--or at least running into Paul away from Corinth at some point.

From where and when Paul, and Sosthenes, wrote is a matter of conjecture. The uninspired postscript says the epistle was written from Philippi. In 1 Corinthians 16:8, Paul actually says he will tarry at Ephesus--he intended to see them in connection with his next passing through Macedonia (1 Cor. 16:5), but apparently that would not be imminent (1 Cor. 16:7) since he was staying at Ephesus until Pentecost--indicating he was in the midst of an extended stay there. When would this book have been written? Paul could have written this sometime around A.D. 54. (*To be continued next week*)
