## HOW WERE JESUS' FEET BONES UNBROKEN? Daniel F. Cates

Looking at the only physical evidence for crucifixion which has been documented archaeologically, one sees the importance of this question. Years ago, an ossuary (or "bone box") was found containing the bones of a crucified man, Yehohanan. Nothing is known of his crime, and the only way that it is known he was crucified is that the box contained his ankle bone--with crucifixion nail embedded *through* it. Apologetics Press' *Reason and Revelation*, October, 2004 (24 (10):91), contained a photo of the ankle and nail with this description: "This rare find of a spiked nail through a human heelbone is the first archaeological evidence that the heels of crucified victims were nailed to a wooden cross, as described in the Bible." The nail is preserved in the bone likely due to its striking a knot in the wood and so twisting that it could not be removed without extra difficulty; therefore, the nail was tossed in the ossuary along with the bones.

Why is this important? Because if crucifixion *always* involved nailing through the ankle bone(s) then the prophecy to which John 19:36 refers would not have been fulfilled. That verse reads, "For these things [the piercing of Jesus' side rather than the breaking of his legs (John 19:32-34)-DFC] were done, that the scripture should be fulfilled, A bone of him shall not be broken." The prophecy itself reads, "He keepeth all his bones: not one of them is broken" (Psalm 34:20).

The case is that it was not necessary for nails to be driven through the ankle bones or any other bones. In reality, there were a number of positions in which people could be crucified, so, logically, there would be different locations for the various nails. Dr. C. Truman Davis writing on "The Passion of Christ from a Medical Point of View" (*Teacher*, March 13, 1986, Vol. 13, No. 3, p. 6) described one process (in context the one most likely used by the executioners of Jesus) thus: The left foot is pressed backward against the right foot, and with both feet extended, toes down, a nail is driven through the arch of each, leaving the knees moderately flexed. ... [T]here is the searing agony of the nail tearing through the nerves between the metatarsal bones of the feet." Note that the nail could be "between the bones."
